Rabbits move their noses up and down to help detect scent. It's called 'nose blinking'. **Foxes** sniff the air to pick up the scent of prey. **Elephants** use their sense of smell to find water far, far away. Their nostrils are at the tip of the trunk.

Cheetahs use their sense of smell to follow herds of their favorite prey and to tell them about other animals in an area. **Bears** have one of the best senses of smell on the planet. They can smell prey over 15 miles away.
