

How do you make a pattern?

Patterns are an arrangement of things that repeat.
You can find patterns in the nature. Look for rows of trees,
animal tracks, or flower petals.

How many patterns can you make?

Paste the frog, squirrel and bird face shapes on to construction paper and cut them out. Lay them in front of you. Look at the examples below. Then start making your own patterns.

Make a moving pattern by hopping over the frog, taking a giant step to climb over the squirrel, and flapping your arms to fly over the bird, then repeat.
