

# GO GRIZZLY!

GUIDE

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**Bears walk on all fours. (Compare and contrast)  
What other animals walk on all fours?**

Giraffe • Zebra • Squirrel • Tiger • Elephant • Hippopotamus  
**How are they alike? How are they different?**



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**How tall are you next to a grizzly bear?**

When standing up on its hind legs a grizzly bear is 8 ft tall. Using a tape measure mark 8 ft on the wall or floor. Compare the size of the bear next to the size of a child. Measure the child. **How much taller is the bear?**

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**How many bear back scratches can you do? (Counting)**

Find an imaginary tree. Pretend to mark it by squatting, wiggling body, and standing back up. Count the number of squats.

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**What do grizzly bears need to survive?**

**(Include living things & non living things)**

Food • Water • Shelter • Air • Light (Sunshine)

Living things move, grow, breathe and reproduce. Plants stay in one spot, but they move their leaves to get sunlight. Non-living things include rocks, water, weather, climate.

**Are you living or nonliving? What do you need to live?** Ask students if their pets at home are living or nonliving.

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**What would you do if you were a bear?**

**(Pretend play scenarios)**

**Where would you sleep, what would you eat, who would be your friend?**

When you are done playing draw a picture of the bear story you created.
